Arrested by the police? You have the right to remain silent



If the police arrest you

- Do tell Police your name and address.
- Do ask to speak to a Lawyer. NAAJA has a 24 hour phone
- Do Not answer any questions or do a recorded interview until you have spoken to a lawyer.
- Do Not sign anything unless it is for bail.

If you don't want to talk to police, tell them your name and address and then say "I don't want to talk" or "No comment" to every question.
